Confirmed Positive Test for COVID 19

SCHOOL PERSONNEL RECEIVING REPORT:

Notify Campus Nurse

STAY HOME (ISOLATE)

Follow the guidance of your healthcare provider.

You may return when:

*At least **10 days** have passed since symptoms first appeared or from first positive test date (asymptomatic test date)

AND

*24 hours have passed without fever or use of fever-reducing meds

STAFF

Enter absences & provide medical documentation to HR

STUDENT

Notify Office/Attendance clerks of absences & provide medical documentation to excuse absences..

Same Household/Direct Exposure

Being directly exposed to someone diagnosed as POSITIVE COVID-19 within the same household.

Fully vaccinated persons and/or persons who have tested positive for COVID within the last 90 days (have antibodies) DO NOT need to quarantine.

STAY HOME (QUARANTINE)

You may opt to return when:

*A minimum of 10 days after last exposure (or lab confirmed positive person began having symptoms) AND free from symptoms. **OR**

*After day 7 from last exposure, after receiving a negative test result (test must occur on day 5 or later)

STAFF

Enter absences when opting to quarantine

STUDENT

Notify campus office/attendance clerks of absences when opting to quarantine

Fully Vaccinated Staff & Students

Fully Vaccinated persons or have tested positive for COVID in the past 90 days (persons with positive antibodies) may participate in all school activities, socially distance when feasible, wash hands often, and cover coughs/sneezes. Masks are optional in all facilities.
